## **BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE USING**

We routinely monitor the conditions in the distribution system. On January 27, 15, we experienced a loss of positive water pressure due to have loss of positive water pressure is a signal of the existence of conditions that could allow contamination to enter the distribution system through back-flow by back-pressure of back-siphonage. As a result, there is an increased chance that the water may contain disease-causing organisms.
What should I do?
<b>DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST.</b> Bring all water to a rolling boil, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using; or use bottled water. You should use boiled or bottled water for drinking making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth, and food preparation until further notice.
Inadequately treated water may contain disease-causing organisms. These organisms include bacteria, viruses and parasites, which can cause symptoms such as nausea, cramps, diarrhea, and associated headaches.
These symptoms, however, are not caused only by organisms in drinking water, but also by other factors. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you may want to seek medical advice.
People with severely compromised immune systems, infants, and some elderly may be at increased risk. These people should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers. General guidelines on ways to lessen the risk of infection by microbes are available from EPA's Safe Drinking Water Hotline at 1 (800) 426-4791.

On bonuary 27, 15 at approximately 9PM we were notified of a bos of pressure by several residents. We are in the process of detecting and correction the problem that created this situation. You will be notified when the problem is corrected and upon no longer need to hail your water.
We will inform you when all corrective actions have been completed and when you no longer need to boil you water.
